## Driving Directions to Portland VA Medical Center:

<b>From the North:</b>	<b>OR</b>	<b>From the West:</b>	<b>From the Northwest:</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Travel South on I-5; cross the Willamette River via the Marquam Bridge, following the signs to City Center/Beaverton.</li> <li>• Take 6th Ave exit. Get in the left lane immediately and turn left on College.</li> <li>• Turn left on Broadway, stay in the right lane, and follow the signs to VA Hospital.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Take I-5 South to Terwilliger Blvd exit.</li> <li>• Stay in the right hand lane and go right at the top of the exit (Barbur Blvd).</li> <li>• At the first light, take a left onto Terwilliger Blvd.</li> <li>• Go through the light at Capitol Hwy.</li> <li>• Follow Terwilliger Blvd. approximately 2-2.5 miles to VA Hospital.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Travel East on US-26/Sunset Hwy, stay in the right lane and follow signs to Salem/The Dalles.</li> <li>• Pass through the Vista Ridge Tunnel, following signs to I-405 South.</li> <li>• Stay in the right lane and take the 6th Ave exit and follow signs to VA Hospital.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Travel Southeast on Hwy 30 (St. Helens Road) towards City Center, following signs to I-405 South.</li> <li>• Take I-405 South, get in the right lane after the US-26/Sunset Hwy exit and then exit at 6th Ave.</li> <li>• Stay in the right lane and follow signs to the VA Hospital.</li> </ul>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Travel North on Macadam.</li> <li>• Turn left on Boundary just past the Johns Landing Water Tower.</li> <li>• Proceed one block and turn right on Corbett.</li> <li>• Come to a four-way stop and turn left on Hamilton, at the next light cross Barbur Blvd. and go up the hill on Hamilton.</li> <li>• Turn right on Terwilliger Blvd. and follow signs to VA Hospital.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Travel North on McLoughlin Blvd. or West on Powell.</li> <li>• Cross the Willamette River via the Ross Island Bridge and take City Center exit.</li> <li>• Follow Corbett as it turns into Kelly, Arthur, and Caruthers.</li> <li>• Stay in the far left lane so that you will be able to turn left on 6th Ave.</li> <li>• Follow signs to VA Hospital.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Travel West on I-84 to the junction of I-5 South.</li> <li>• Follow I-5 across the Willamette River via the Marquam Bridge.</li> <li>• Take 6th Ave exit and get in the left lane immediately and turn left on College.</li> <li>• Turn left on Broadway, stay in the right lane and follow signs to VA Hospital.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Travel North on I-5; take the Terwilliger Blvd. exit and turn left.</li> <li>• Follow Terwilliger Blvd. approximately 2.5 miles, crossing Barbur Blvd. and Capital Hwy.</li> <li>• Follow signs to VA Hospital/OHSU.</li> </ul>

## Parking:

- From Terwilliger, turn on to SW US Veterans Hospital Road. You will see where to turn by a sign that says Portland VA Medical Center.



- Go past Day Use and employee lots (Lots 1 and 9 on the map) to the stop sign, do not turn into the parking lot entrance to the left of the stop sign – this is for employees only. Go straight after the stop sign and take the next left toward the Visitor/Patient Parking, and left again into the parking structure (designated by the yellow circle “entrance to P” on the map).



- If an attendant asks you the reason for your visit, please say you have a Research appointment at the NCRAR.

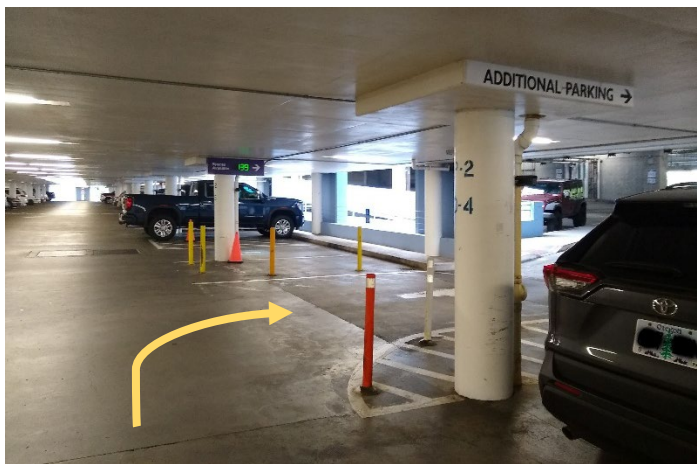




- To your left, you will see the parking garage entrance. Turn left into the parking structure, immediately veer right (in the direction of the arrows) to enter the first row of parking (all the way over to the right).



- Go all the way to the end of the first row of parking places. As you go around the end and start heading back up the other side, take the first right into a lane marked "Additional Parking". Park in this section if possible (this is Lot 3 on the map). **Please allow extra time for parking because spaces are limited.**



### Finding NCRAR:

- If you are early, please wait in your car until about 15 minutes (at most) before your scheduled appointment time. If anyone accompanied you to the VA, please do not bring them with you into the building.
- Please put your mask on before you leave your car (this is hospital policy). If you forgot a mask, please try to stay 6 feet away from anyone else as you enter the building. A mask will be provided when you arrive at the NCRAR.

**\*\*PLEASE TAKE NOTE OF WHERE YOU HAVE PARKED** so you can find your car easily after your appointment.

- Immediately to your right as you entered Lot 3 you will see a sliding glass door that says “Mental Health”. After you have parked, go through this door to the elevators inside. This is parking level P2 and these are the elevators you will need to access our facility.



- Take these elevators down to level P5 (bottom floor). We are the only facility on this level. On level P5, you will take a left out of the elevator and see two big glass doors. This is the **National Center for Rehabilitative Auditory Research (NCRAR)**.



- Before entering the lobby, please sanitize your hands, and make sure you are wearing a face mask. If you brought your own mask, we may ask you to change to a mask we provide. Please wait in the lobby for someone to assist you.
- **NOTE:** If you end up approaching the main hospital building instead (building 100 on the map), there will be someone monitoring the entrance to the building. Please ask for directions to **Building 104** and DO NOT enter the main VA hospital lobby.
  - From the front of the VA, cross the street. Look for the entrance to Primary Care – the elevators you need are just past the doors for Primary Care. Take the elevators to P5.
