## Study #3712 Uncovering Physiological Markers of Hidden Hearing Loss

The VA RR&D National Center for Rehabilitative Auditory Research (NCRAR) at the VA Portland Healthcare System is currently looking for volunteers to participate in a hearing-related research study to develop new clinical tests that can better detect hearing damage.

### Participants must have good hearing and be 19-35 years old

- The study consists of **one 2 hour screening visit and 4-6 test sessions.**
- **Test sessions will take 2-3 hours each** and will include questionnaires and a series of hearing tests.
- The hearing tests include raising your hand to sounds and tests in which certain physical responses are measured as you to listen to sound while you sleep or watch a silent movie.
- Qualified subjects will receive **\$30 for the screening visit and \$30-45 per test session.**

*By participating you will be contributing to research that will benefit patients in the future. In addition, you may benefit from receiving a hearing test and learning what your hearing is like.*
